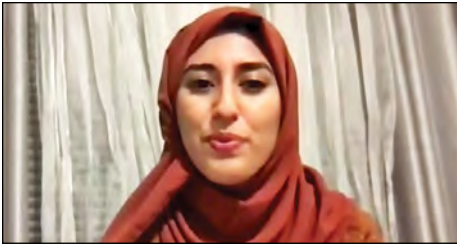

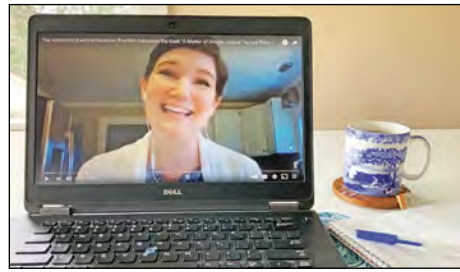

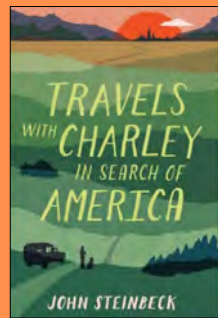

150 years of the Camden Herald to be available to view/search online

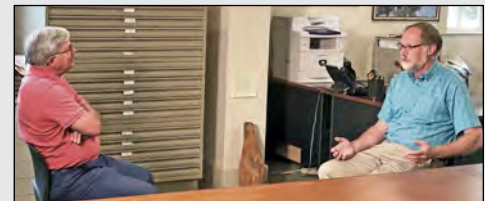


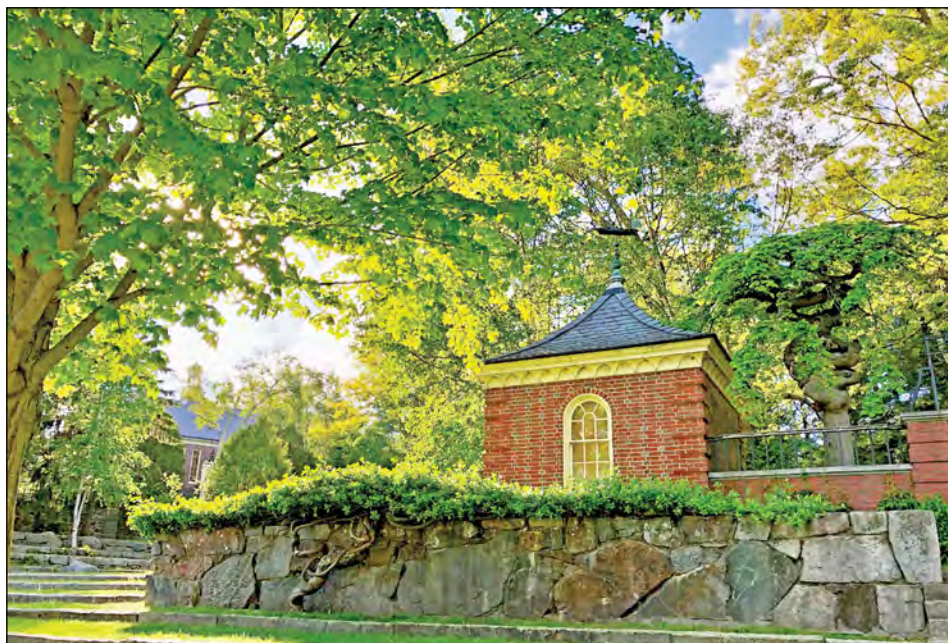
